**DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW 5M<sup>3</sup>/DAY WATER TREATMENT PLANT AT DURNACOL**

Bids are hereby invited from experienced and suitably qualified contractors for the design and construction of a new 5M<sup>3</sup>/day potable water package treatment plant at the existing Durnacol water treatment works. Only bidders who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being registered prior to the closing date of the tender, in a contractor grading of 6ME, will be eligible to bid. Bidders must have experience in the design, manufacture and installation of potable water package treatment plants

To be eligible for evaluation, bidders must achieve a minimum Quality Score of 70%, assessed in terms of objective criteria for experience, financial resources, key personnel, quality assurance and previous performance.

As set out in F2.1 of the Bid Document, bidders' are to note the requirement to achieve a stipulated minimum threshold per designated sectors and products.

The 90/10 preference point system will be applicable as prescribed in Amajuba District Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of both price and functionality. A Bid that scores less than 70 points out of 100 in respect of functionality will not be considered for further evaluation.

NB: Bidders are required to submit original tax clearance certificate and original valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate(s) or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Failure to submit the B-BBEE verification Certificate will result in forfeiting the points by the bidder.

Bid documents will be made available as from the **03 of April 2017** to the **11<sup>th</sup> of April 2017** at the SCM Unit of the Amajuba District Municipality upon producing proof of payment of a non-refundable fee of **R500** per document. Deposits must be made to the Amajuba District Municipality bank account: **ABSA Bank Account No. 4053472593 with the number obtained from the Amajuba District Municipality as reference.** Bidders will be required to produce proof of the deposit before they will be issued a bid document.
